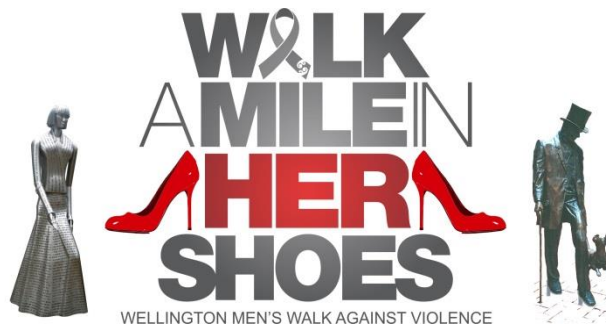
INSTRUCTIONS
